### **Sexual Integrity Program Update**By James Wells, SIP Director

Hello! It is my privilege to share with you that in the Fall of 2010, our Sexual Integrity Program directly reached out to 2,053 students in



Union, Columbia, and Ouachita counties. While educating these students about the benefits of abstinence and how it is the healthiest and safest choice until marriage, we were able to give them some helpful information so they are better equipped to "think" before they act. As I tell the students, "We can't make you do anything you don't want to do, but it is our hope that we can give you enough knowledge to make an informed decision".

Here are a few examples of the information we share with the students in class:

- 1 in 5 Americans are infected with a sexually transmitted disease (STD).
- 1 in 4 sexually active teens will graduate high school with an STD.
- There is no such thing as "safe sex".
- Over the course of a year in a sexually active relationship, condoms are only 85% effective in preventing pregnancy.
- Abstinence is the only 100% effective way to keep from getting an STD or getting pregnant.

It is my prayer that at the end of the week we have planted the seeds of truth into these young people's hearts so they can make the right choices when tough situations happen.







## Fruits of the Ministry &

A 14-year-old girl by the name of Georgia, walked through our doors, single and 3 months pregnant, inquiring about ways she could earn items such as diapers, clothes, food, and toys for her soon-to-be newborn. When we first met Georgia we had the opportunity to sit down with her, talk with her, and get to know her better. We went through our counseling form together and this gave us a chance to listen to any of her concerns and to try to answer any questions she had regarding childbirth, etc. We talked about our Earn While You Learn (EWYL) Moms and Mentors parenting classes, where she could earn items for her baby, and that day she enrolled in the classes.

The EWYL classes are designed to help clients become the best parents they can be, while teaching them everything from A-Z about pregnancy and parenting. For example, prenatal care, the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd trimesters, postpartum, newborn care, reducing the risk of SIDS, infant and toddler First Aid, toilet training, car seat safety, the importance of bonding, and the

list goes on and on! Little did we know that she would be so faithful in attending the classes that she would earn over \$400 worth of



baby items and only miss a couple of classes the entire time she was enrolled. She also gave her testimony at the El Dorado banquet last September of how the Hannah Pregnancy Resource Center has helped her in establishing a better life for herself and her baby boy!

We had the privilege of doing several ultrasounds for Georgia where we got to see her precious baby boy, Peyton Lane. We all just couldn't wait until he arrived to get to see him! Peyton Lane was born on August 9 and weighed 8lbs 6oz and was 21 inches long. From getting to know Georgia, we can say with 100% certainty that she is a very special young lady who is dedicated to being the best mother she can be!
